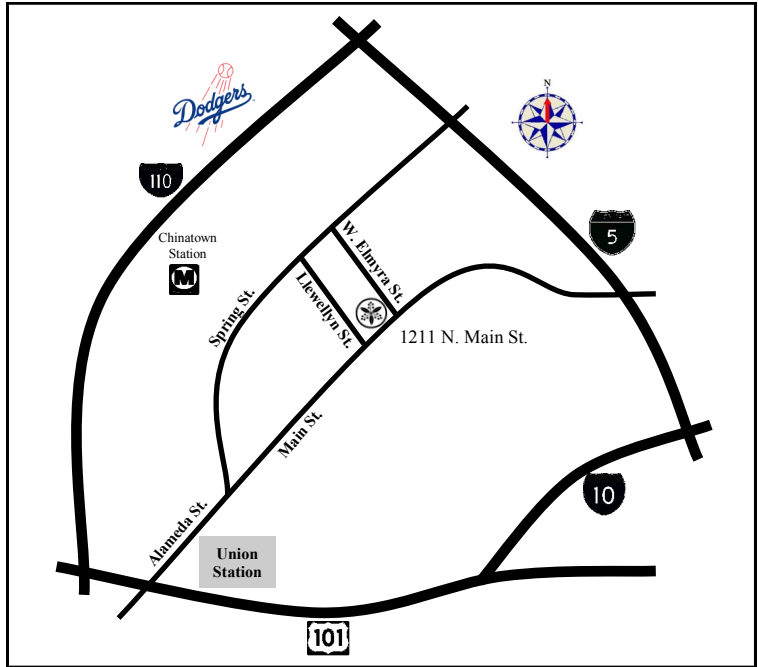

Sensei earned his degree in Asian Studies jointly at the University of Southern California and Harvard University. He trained at the Aikido World Headquarters in Tokyo, Japan in 1969 under the late Kisshomaru Ueshiba, Doshu. Furuya Sensei was ordained as a Zen priest in 1988 and also has received the honor to speak at the United Nations. He was the author of countless articles on martial arts and Japanese culture and has appeared on numerous television programs speaking about those subjects. He authored the book *Kodo: Ancient Ways*, and the nine volume video series, *The Art of Aikido*.
